- 6. It is recommended that items for exhibit not be used before entering in the fair. <u>Cleanliness counts.</u>
- 7. Limited to one entry per person per section.
- 8. Prizes to be awarded will include one blue, one red, and one white ribbon for each section at the judge's discretion. Premiums will be given as described in the General Rules.
- 9. One Champion ribbon and two Reserve Champion will awarded in this department.
